Competition Guidelines:

- This competition is open to all high school and community college students in Brevard County.
- The speech/essay must be an informative presentation that fits into the theme:
“Education: Building Bridges towards a Common Ground of Equality and Justice”
- Each entrant **MUST** be present at the festival competition on Thursday, **March 6, 2008** at 3:00 pm in the building #1 - lecture hall on the Titusville campus of Brevard Community College.
- One entry from the high school finalists and one entry from the community college finalists presenting at the Moore Heritage Festival of the Arts and Humanities will be selected to receive an award at the **Festival Gala Banquet on Friday, March 7 at 6:30 pm**. The Festival Gala Banquet will be held at the Holiday Inn Express-Space Coast Convention Center, Cocoa, FL. Each award winner will be provided with one complimentary ticket to the banquet. Additional tickets are available for purchase for friends/family members. Award winners must be properly attired to attend the Gala banquet. Young men should wear at least a shirt & tie with dress slacks. Young ladies should wear an appropriate dress or pant suit.
- The winning presenters will also receive **one tuition-free class at BCC, a trac phone, and a \$50.00 cash prize.**
- The speech must be an original work created by the student who is writing and presenting it.
- The speech must be no longer than **three** minutes. Any speech going over the allotted time will be disqualified.
- The judge’s decisions are final.
- A written version of each participant’s speech must be submitted to Mrs. Annetha Jones, Titusville High School, by Friday, February 29, 2008.
